**Re: Year 11 Students**

You will recall that for us and Year 11 these unprecedented times began 23 March. Since that time we have endeavoured to stay in touch with you and your son/daughter through newsletters, updates, texts, tutor emails, Firefly and, in some cases, personal phone calls.

After May half term would, under normal circumstances, be the time when Year 11 exams would be in full swing and students would only be attending school for their exams and revision classes. Although we are not experiencing normal circumstances right now, we feel that we have met all student academic and pastoral needs. Therefore, after half term we will consider the Year 11 students as having left. This means the following:

1. There will be no further communication from tutors, teachers, or the year team, unless relating to a specific need/issue. This includes parent and student newsletters.

5. At this stage we have no further information regarding the Year 11 prom, other than it remains cancelled. When we are in a position to provide updates we will do so.
6. GCSE results day will take place, as originally planned nationally, on Thursday 20 August. We will be contacting you and students nearer the time with details of how students can attend school to collect these, or have them posted to home. If your child wishes to attend Caludon's sixth form, we will issue details at a later date about how this may be progressed on results day.
7. We will be contacting you regarding how Year 11 photographs, and year book where relevant, can be distributed.

In the meantime, we thank you for your continued support throughout this year, and the most recent times, and trust that you will stay safe.
