Sixth Form Enrolment:

If you would like to enrol in Caludon sixth form, you will need to do that on the same day. Members of the sixth form team will be available to help with enrolment into our sixth form. After collecting your results, you will be directed to the relevant member of the sixth form team to enrol on the courses you wish to study next year; this will be dependent on exam grades and the specific entry requirements for each course. If you are unable to enrol during this time, you will need to contact the school as we have a limited number of places on some courses so cannot guarantee any student enrolling later having a full set of subject options available to them. Concerns about your results

When you receive your results, if you are not happy with a grade, your first step should be to speak to Mr Carter for advice.

As we have returned to externally awarded grades, the only appeals we can make will be a re-mark of your papers. Historically, the majority of reviews do not result in a grade change; the occasions this has been successful is when a student is within 2% of the next grade boundary. Grades can also be adjusted down so we would not advise a review if your score is not close the grade boundary above. There is a cost involved in any review. Details below:
