

BYOD – BRING YOUR OWN DEVICE STUDENT AGREEMENT (AUPB)

Purpose:


Many students' lives today are filled with media that gives them mobile access to information and resources 24/7. Outside school, students are free to pursue their interest in their own way and at their own pace. The opportunities are limitless, borderless, and instantaneous. To put students at the centre and empower them to take control of their own learning, The school will allow students to use personal technology devices. Students wishing to participate must follow the responsibilities stated in the BYOD Acceptable Use Policy as well as the following guidelines.

Device Types:

For this program, the word “device” means a privately owned wireless and/or portable electronic piece of equipment that includes laptops, netbooks, tablets or slates, and smart phones.


Guidelines:

1. Any student who wishes to use a personally owned electronic device within the bounds of the school site must read the BYOD Acceptable Use Policy and sign this agreement online agreement (see below). They can also only access the BYOD network by logging in using their school authentication details (see below).

2. The student takes full responsibility for his or her device and always keeps it with himself or herself or locked away. Whilst Caludon provides lockable lockers, it is not responsible for the security of the device.
3. The student is responsible for the proper care of their personal device, including any costs of repair, replacement or any modifications needed to use the device at school.
4. Caludon reserves the right to inspect a student's personal device if there is reason to believe that the student has violated School policies, BYOD Acceptable Use Policy, administrative procedures, school rules or has engaged in other misconduct while using their personal device.
5. Violations of any school policies, administrative procedures or school rules involving a student's personally owned device may result in the loss of use of the device in school and/or disciplinary action.
6. The student complies with teachers' request to shut down the computer or close the screen or put the device away.
7. Personal devices shall be charged prior to bringing it to school and shall be capable of running off its own battery while at school.
8. The student may not use the devices to record, transmit or post photos or video of a person or persons on campus unless directed to do so and under supervision from a teacher. Nor can any images or video recorded at school be transmitted or posted at any time without the express permission of a teacher.
9. The student should only use their device to access relevant files, programs and/or applications.
10. The student will use the assigned wireless network. Use of 3G & 4G wireless connections is not allowed.
