As a part of your child's education at Caludon Castle School, we promote personal wellbeing and development through a comprehensive Personal, Social, Health and Economic education programme in our Personal Development lessons. Personal Development is a curriculum subject that gives young people the knowledge, understanding, attitudes and practical skills to live safe, healthy, productive lives and meet their full potential.

We are writing to let you know that, over the spring term starting Tuesday 9 January 2024, students will have Personal Development lessons which will focus on relationships and sex education (RSE). As a school community, we are committed to working in partnership with parents; the RSE lessons were discussed with the recent parent forum to ensure the content was matched to the students' needs and understanding. Most of the content is required under the Statutory Guidance for Relationships Education, Relationships and Sex Education and Health Education of 2019. RSE lessons will include the following topics:

- Families and people who care for me
- Respectful relationships – including friendships
- Online/media
- Being safe
- Intimate & sexual relationships including sexual health – in Y7 this topic is puberty and adolescence

Students will also have opportunities to ask questions that help prepare them for relationships of all kinds in the modern world.


