Personal Development is a curriculum subject that gives young people the knowledge, understanding, attitudes and practical skills to live safe, healthy, productive lives and meet their full potential.

We are writing to let you know that, over the spring term starting Tuesday 9 January 2024, students will have Personal Development lessons which will focus on relationships and sex education (RSE). Most of the content is required under the Statutory Guidance for Relationships Education, Relationships and Sex Education and Health Education of 2019.
